## General Assistance – Kauai County

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**Note:** Resources listed here serve the island of Kauai but may have a physical presence and contact information for Oahu only.

This is a listing of a wide range of resources, including those having to do with air travel, assistive technology, benefits, caregivers, disabilities, emergency notifications, employment, energy assistance, financial assistance, financial counseling, food assistance, household safety, housing, independent living services, insurance, legal aid, pill reminder services, service animals for those who are not blind, and services for women and children.

“Assistive technology” mean any kind of equipment or device or system that helps a person who has a disability. These are things like wheelchairs, walkers, glasses, hearing aids, computer screen magnifiers, ramps, special handles and grips, lights on telephones, closed captioning on TV and movie screens, and more.

“Independent living,” for persons with disabilities, means having equal opportunities, self-respect, being able to decide things for themselves, and advocating for themselves, among other things.

### **Aloha Independent Living Hawaii**

Aloha Independent Living Hawaii (AILH) serves persons with disabilities on all islands. Services are free and the only eligibility requirement is that consumers must be a person with a disability. They provide five core services: 1) Information and referral; 2) peer counseling; 3) advocacy; 4) independent living skills; and 5) transition (young people with disabilities transitioning to employment, further education, or independent living, or helping people transition from health care facilities back to community-based living or help people avoid entering institutions.

### **Carrier Alert Program**

Carrier Alert is a cooperative community service program to monitor the well-being of elderly and disabled mail patrons. As one of the few—and some days only—point of human contact for home-bound patrons, letter carriers are particularly attuned to signs that could mean an accident or illness.

When a volunteer carrier notes something unusual concerning a patron registered with Carrier Alert, he or she reports it to a postal supervisor or other designated individual who in turn contacts the sponsoring local agency. They check on the person and if something's wrong, contact family, police or emergency services as appropriate.

### **General Assistance (GA), State of Hawaii**

Provides cash benefits for food, clothing, shelter, and other essentials to adults ages 18 – 64, without minor dependents, who are temporarily disabled and do not qualify for Social Security. To be eligible, the adult must have little or no income, not qualify for a federal category of assistance, and be certified by a Department of Human Services medical board to be unable to engage in any substantial employment of at least thirty hours per week for a period of at least 60 days.

### **Kupuna Caregivers Program**

In July 2017 Governor David Ige signed into law, HB 607 appropriating \$600,000 to the Executive Office on Aging (EOA) to establish the Kupuna Caregivers program, aimed at supporting working caregivers. Recognizing the tremendous contributions of caregivers, the bill provides financial assistance to support employed caregivers to remain in the workforce, provided certain criteria are met. EOA and the county Area Agencies on Aging are working to develop and implement the program. EOA plans to launch the Kupuna Caregivers program in 2018.

It means that instead of looking for a cure, the goal is to make the person as comfortable as possible and have the best quality of life in the time that remains.

"Palliative care" includes pain management and symptom management. It is sometimes also called "supportive care" or "concurrent care." It can take place at the patient's own home, nursing home, or hospital. Palliative care is also for persons who are sick but are not dying. The goal is to help them live longer, happier lives by managing their conditions as best as possible so they don't interfere with patients' lives.

## **In-Home, Supported Living, and Respite Care – Kauai County**

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“In-home care” means services that help a person with special needs stay in their home. This includes kupuna, people recovering from surgery, or persons with disabilities. It can mean personal care, homemaking chores, cooking or delivering meals, and having home health care.

“Supported living” is for persons with disabilities. They receive ongoing support that helps them live where they want, with whom they want, and for long as they want. Support includes services such as supported living coaches, employment or day training, transportation, companions, and chore and homemaker services, among others.

“Respite care” is the short-term care of a person who is sick elderly, or disabled. It temporarily provides relief for their caregivers. It could be for just an afternoon, several days, or even weeks. The care can take place at home, in a healthcare facility, or at an adult day care center.

## **Therapists (OT, PT, RT, Rehab) – Kauai County Occupational, Physical, Recreational, and Speech Therapists**

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Occupational therapy (OT) – A kind of therapy (a way to get better) from a physical or mental illness that focuses on activities that we do in our daily lives. This could include things like helping people learn how to take care of themselves again, helping children with disabilities be able to go to school, learning how to work again, and more.

Physical therapy (PT) – A way to treat a disease or injury by using physical methods such as exercise, massage, and heat treatment, among others. The idea is to save, make better, or restore movement and physical function.

Recreational therapy (RT) – This therapy uses recreation and other activity-based work to help people recover from illnesses and / or disabling conditions. The treatment is specially designed for the person and might include arts and crafts, cooking, dance, music, drama, social activities, fitness activities, games, puzzles, writing, and more.

Speech therapy (speech and language pathologist, or SLPs) – SLPs are experts in communication. They work with people of all ages from babies to adults. They treat many times of communication and swallowing problems.
